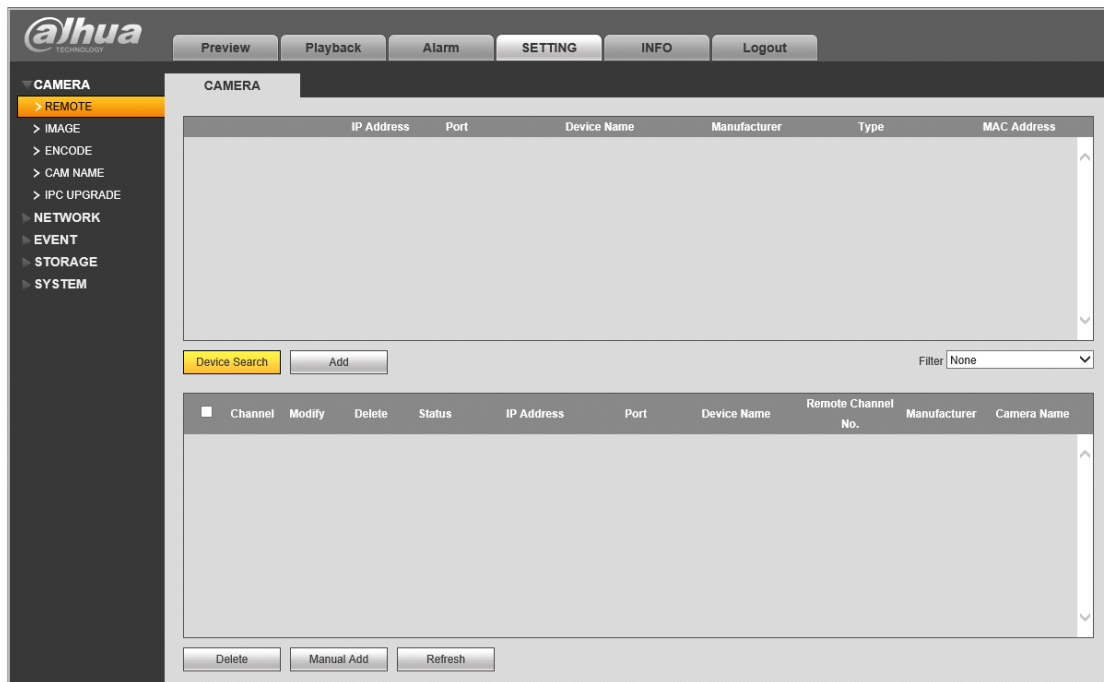
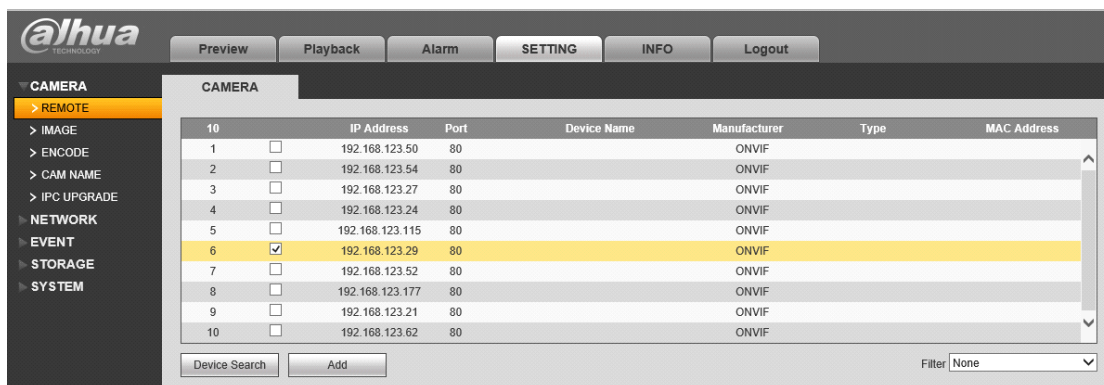


Dahua NVR integration with DoorBird IP Video Door Station


1. Log into Dahua's user interface.
2. Go to **Settings** and press **Device Search**.



3. Locate your DoorBird IP Video Station in the list, mark its check box and press the **Add** button. Note that it appears as an ONVIF device.




4. Your device will appear in the list below the search results. Press on the pen icon to modify it.
