

SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

- DoorBird IP Video Door Station
- Yale Smart Lock
 - There are three categories of Yale Smart Locks, differentiated by how they establish a connection to the internet
 - Locks with an **inbuilt** WiFi connection
 - Locks which require **only** a Yale/August Connect Bridge (in some cases, this is bundled with the lock and in others it is sold separately)
 - Locks which require a Yale Connect Bridge **and** Access Module (in some cases this is pre-installed inside the lock and in others it is sold separately)
 - If you aren't sure which type of lock you have, or if your lock has an Access Module, then refer to the documentation supplied with your smart lock or contact Yale Customer Support in your territory.

SCOPE OF INTEGRATION

The following guide will take you through the steps of setting up a DoorBird IP Video Door Station in connection with a Yale Smart Lock.

With this integration you are able to unlock the Yale smart lock directly from within the DoorBird app whilst on call with a visitor. This eliminates the need to switch back and forth between apps whilst in an active call.

This integration also works with our A1101 Indoor Station, allowing you to unlock the lock directly from the Indoor Station.


To lock the door, the Yale Home/Access app must be used; this functionality is currently not possible in the DoorBird app.

Additionally, you cannot trigger the Yale Smart Lock using the DoorBird keypad or RFID reader.


1. SETTING UP THE DOORBIRD IP VIDEO DOOR STATION

For the DoorBird IP Video Door Station to be properly able to communicate with the Yale Smart Lock, the DoorBird device's settings must be adjusted accordingly.

1.1 Open the DoorBird App and tap the cog wheel symbol on the bottom right to enter the settings screen.




1.2 Tap the device you wish to configure.




1.3 On the following screen, scroll down and tap the field in the "SMARTLOCKS" section.




1.4 From the list of compatible smart locks, choose either **Yale Access** for if you're based in the **US** and **Yale Home** for **all other countries**.




1.6 You will subsequently be presented with the Yale Login screen. Enter your Yale login credentials and tap "Sign In".




1.7 After logging in, a verification code will be sent to your smartphone via SMS. Enter it in the following field and tap "Verify".



1.8 When prompted with the required app privileges, tap “Agree”.



Note: Should you have multiple Yale locks associated with this account, you will be asked to select which one to connect with your DoorBird IP Video Door Station.



You have now successfully completed the setup of the Yale Smart Lock.
